



Preschool Discipline Policy

Positive Behavior Techniques:

Individual to the teacher but, include whole class and individual incentives.

Behavior infractions include:

- Outbursts; yelling, crying, etc.,
- Inappropriate language
- Hitting, kicking and/or biting others
- Destroying materials
- Refusing to comply
- Disrespect toward staff/argumentative
- Verbal threats toward a student or adult
- Running away from staff
- Disruption of naptime

Consequences:

1. Verbal Warning
2. Recess/Other Activities withheld in age-appropriate time increments
3. Visit to the office/contact parents
4. If behavior continues, after 2 visits to the office in a day, parents will have to pick up
5. If the behavior continues to occur, a meeting will be held to discuss next steps

*If called to be picked up, a parent/guardian must pick up within the hour.

*If school property is damaged due to a student's behavior, parents will be held responsible for the cost of repair or replacement.
